



Youth Coach Apprenticeship Program Spring & Summer 2023

Position Summary: Youth Coaches (YC) will commit to an exciting spring and summer season at Delta Sculling Center, where they will work within our programs as assistant coaches, while continuing to learn and grow professionally. No rowing experience required!

Youth Coaches will be placed in a specific role, and through key mentorship from Delta Sculling Center staff, they will learn sculling skills, get experience in working with youth participants and attain valuable skills to launch into a successful career path as young professionals who are in great demand in our sport. In addition, YC will be immersed in Delta Sculling Center's diverse community of hard-working staff, supporters, and volunteers. It is our hope that through DSC's large network, YCs will be able to find, establish, and grow their own professional network.

Youth Coach Responsibilities: Delta Sculling Center hopes to hire 2-3 Youth Coaches from now until August 2023. The YCs will undergo approximately four months of onboarding and training to learn the fundamentals of land rowing, sculling, coaching, youth development, teamwork, and to obtain USRowing coaching certification, CPR and First Aid, and their CA boating license.

Each role will include assisting in the day-to-day operations of the programs at Delta Sculling Center, including:

- Coaching the fundamentals of land rowing, sculling, and general strength and conditioning
- Supporting participants socially and emotionally
- Preparing, maintaining and repairing equipment and facilities
- Managing data and information including attendance and program metrics
- Administrative support for internal and external communications

Position Details

- Youth coaches will sign on for approximately 4-months (May - August 2023)
- Part-time role of 12-20 hours a week
- Schedules will be flexible and based on candidates' availability
- Onboarding will occur in May 2023. Attendance at onboarding is mandatory
- Delta Sculling Center's Executive Director will help oversee all aspects of the Youth Coach Apprenticeship Program, and each position will have a direct supervisor that youth coaches will report to regularly

What is Delta Sculling Center Looking For?

- **No rowing experience necessary. Experience in other sports or fitness helpful**
- Commitment to community service and a strong belief in the power of committed individuals to effect positive change in society
- Someone who is confident in and out of the water
- A desire to learn and buy into the vision of Delta Sculling Center
- A positive "can do" approach to tasks and challenges
- Experience and/or a desire to work with young people from diverse backgrounds

- Strong interpersonal skills, patience, and a sense of humor
- Ability to commit to the program (including onboarding) through August 2023. Preference to candidates that can stay beyond August 2023

What is the Compensation?

Pay:

- Part-time Youth Coaches will work an average of 12 hours and up to 20 hours/week. Pay for these positions is competitive and based on experience, with the range of \$18-\$20
- Candidates that complete the program in good standing with DSC will be eligible to receive an end of service bonus
- You would be offered a part-time role to begin August 2023 upon satisfactory completion of the program

Benefits:

Part-Time Roles

- Sick leave is available for part-time employees, accruing at a rate of 1 hour for every 30 hours worked
- Strong references from the DSC leadership team
- DSC apparel

Professional Development:

- Youth coaches will access the following professional development:
 - Mentorship from DSC staff
 - Attend applicable youth development, engagement, and empowerment workshops
 - Have regular mentorship cohort meetings to share experiences, provide resources for one another, and give/receive feedback
